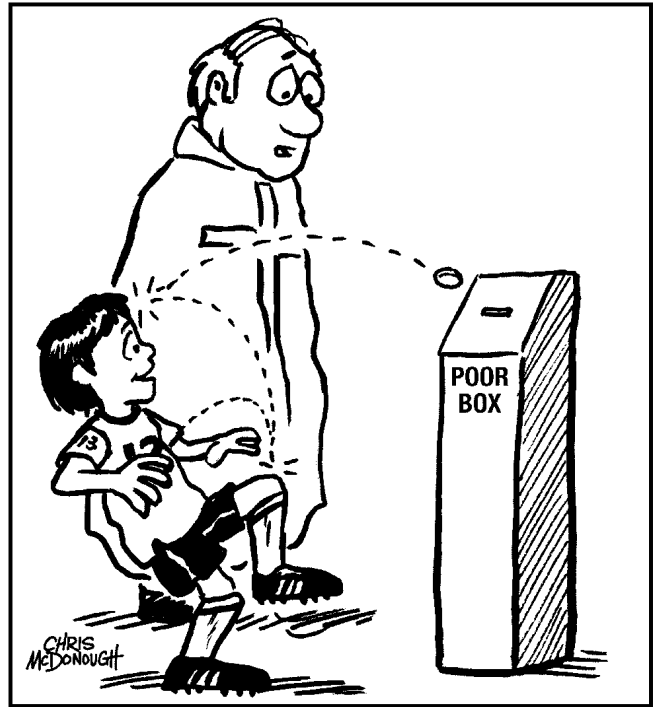

REPORT CHILD ABUSE OF ANY KIND
